

# Spree Expeditions, Inc.

## Terms and Conditions

### Group Travel



**Group Travel:** Group travel is classified as ½ boat or full- boat charter. Group travel dates are secured upon receipt of a completed Booking Agreement and booking fee. Dates will be held on a verbal agreement for 2 weeks, but will be released for other parties if Agreement and booking fee are not received by Spree Expeditions within that 2-week period.

**Payment Policy:** A non-refundable 10% booking fee is required from all booking agents and dive stores to secure a requested charter date. An additional non-refundable 30% payment is due 60 days prior to departure, with final payment due 30 days prior to departure. Invoices will be delivered electronically to your email address of record.

**Cancellations:** All notices of cancellations MUST be received in writing (e-mail [info@spreeexpeditions.com](mailto:info@spreeexpeditions.com)). If the entire charter is cancelled more than 60 days prior to departure, the 10% booking fee is forfeited. If the entire charter is cancelled between 60 to 31 days prior to departure, 40% of the charter fee is forfeited. Cancellations within 30 days of departure result in the forfeit of the entire charter fee and no refund is available. Partial cancellations or reductions from original reservation will be adjusted by the percentage of remaining passengers. Free spaces will be adjusted based on the remaining number of passengers.

Thirty days prior to the scheduled departure date all unsold spaces must be fully paid or released, making them available for sale through the Spree Expeditions website. Please note that you will still be able to sell spots and get credit for them during this time.

**Free Spaces:** One free space is earned for a minimum of 8 sold. Two free spaces are earned for a minimum of 16 sold. The number of booked passengers at time of departure will determine free-space allocation. On the advice of our insurance carrier, we will continue to NOT provide an in-water divemaster/dive guide for the divers.

**Refund Policy:** **Full refunds** will be made when a trip is cancelled prior to leaving the dock due to weather, mechanical problems, etc. **Partial refunds** for any trip cut short due to mechanical problems will be determined by Spree Expeditions, Inc. on a case-by-case basis based on number of dives offered. Vouchers will be issued for trips cut short for any reason other than mechanical, again based on number of dives offered. We are confident that passengers will feel they have been treated fairly.

**If departure is cancelled or delayed due to weather or any other circumstances beyond our control, including but not limited to mechanical failure, we will have no liability to you other than to refund your payment or issue a voucher (individual) for future travel. We strongly recommend travel insurance and diving insurance for your customers.**

**Spree Expeditions, Inc. reserves the right to cancel any M/V Spree charter due to inadequate bookings that make the trip economically unfeasible to operate. In this case a full refund will be given to the client.**

**Online Payment Option Policy:** Groups electing to use the online payment option are still required to complete a Booking Agreement and secure the booking with a 10% non-refundable deposit. Spree bookings and payments handled through the online booking system require the diver to be entered in the online Spree Booking System and payment received in full by Spree Expeditions, Inc. before the diver is considered “booked”. All transactions will be the responsibility of Spree Expeditions, Inc. The booking agent will be issued a commission check and refund of deposit once the trip departs.

**Weather Call:** Weather decisions are made at departure time, except in the event of catastrophic weather (Hurricane). Accommodations will be provided aboard for all guests in the case of a delayed departure.

**Boarding Policy:** Passengers arriving early will be allowed to leave their luggage on the dock, but will not be allowed onboard. Early arriving passengers must entertain themselves off the boat until boarding time.
